Labour CND Priorities for 2018

Our central campaigning priorities for the year ahead are:

- scrapping Trident
- campaign for the Labour Party to commit to signing and ratifying the UN Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons
- supporting denuclearisation of the Korean Peninsula
- opposing Britain's participation in military action in the Middle East and elsewhere

In the Labour Party we're looking to:

- encourage debate and build support for the creation of a Shadow Defence Diversification Agency, in line with the commitment made by Jeremy Corbyn in his 2015 leadership campaign and Motion 17 to the 2017 Trade Union Congress
- strengthen member involvement in Labour policy making
- encourage motions on nuclear disarmament and related topics at all levels of the party

And we hope to increase support for Labour CND by:

- maintaining and improving digital communications, including a regular e-newsletter
- providing speakers for local Labour Party debates/meetings
- establishing more Labour CND local networks and groups
- continuing to encourage greater Britain-wide representation on the Labour CND committee
- campaigning for representation on the Labour CND committee by affiliated trade unions
